Within these pages you will find twenty small dungeon maps (roughly a quarter of a page in size) that can be used to expand upon an existing dungeon -or- used as specific areas of interest in an otherwise uninhabited and/or ruined complex (where mapping out the entire dungeon is unnecessary - much like the 'dwarven mines' featured in Tolkien's works).

In addition to this pdf booklet, all twenty maps have also been supplied as individual image files (see the separate download) - enabling you to use these dungeons in conjunction with a virtual tabletop. Furthermore, each map has also been numbered\* (one through twenty) - so that you can also generate an area of dungeon randomly (should you ever have the need).

*\*note that the 'random dungeon description and encounter' charts, in CSP's upcoming 'dungeons' book, will make use of these.*







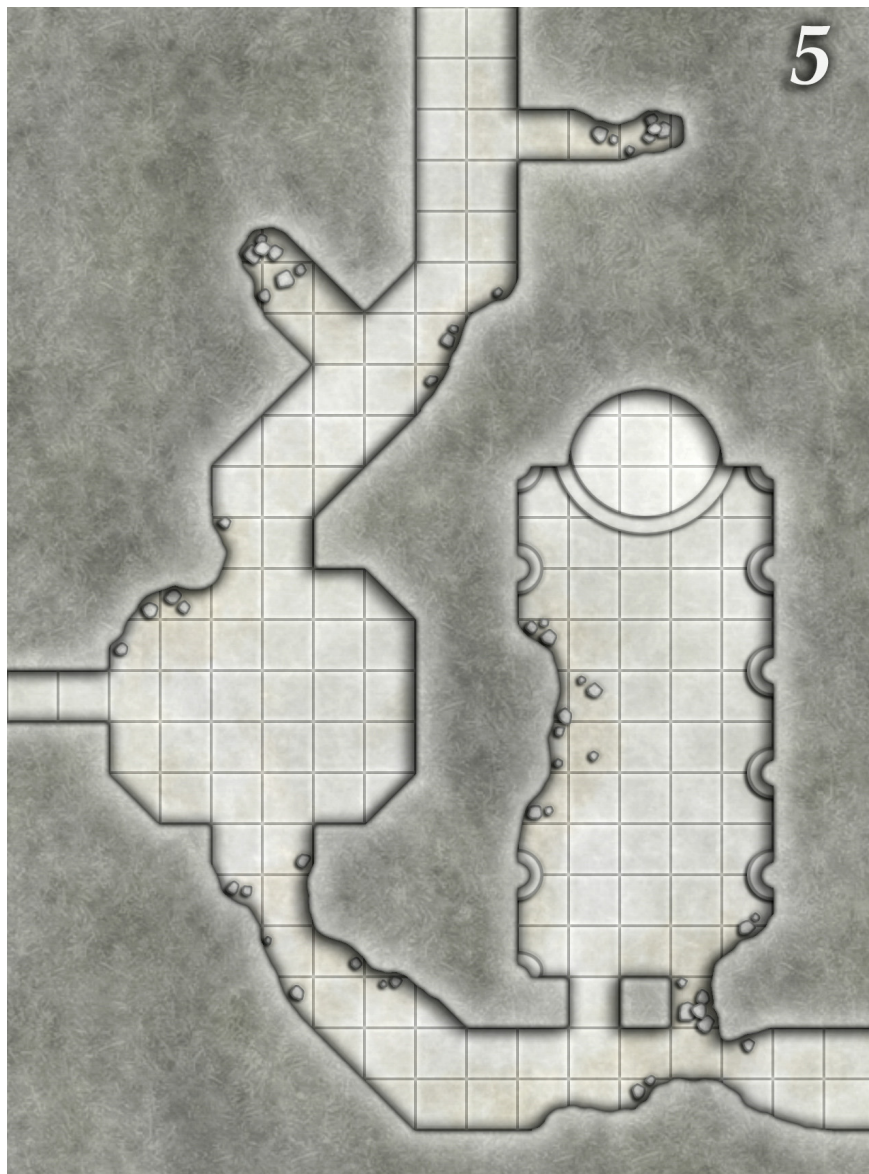

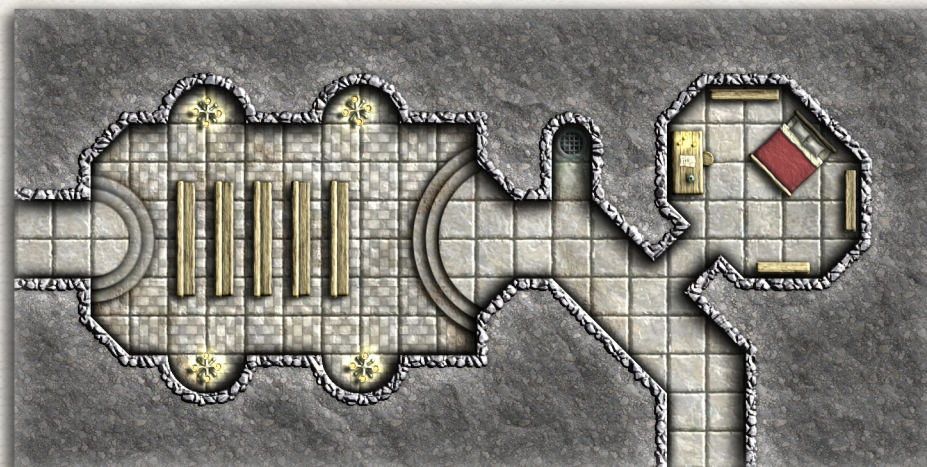


# KRISTIAN RICHARDS IS CREATING **DUNGEON GEOMORPHS** ON PATREON
