Hey there, Web-Heads, and welcome to the first letter column for our new volume of AMAZING SPIDER-MAN. We've been flooded with mail over the last few months, so let's waste no time in getting to your letters. Before we dive into the mailbag for the new issues, let's take one last look at the previous volume of ASM!

Dear Amazing Spider-Mail, and Dan Slott in particular:

I was genuinely touched by Dan Slott's final issue of AMAZING SPIDER-MAN. While "Go Down Swinging" was filled with the stakes and status quo shakes one would hope for from a grand finale, this was a coda on what is wonderful about a friendly neighborhood super hero. Looking back on the run as a whole now, it's easy to see how high the highs were, with new classics like SUPERIOR SPIDER-MAN and SPIDER-VERSE. Marcos Martin always seems to bring out the depth and poetry in Mr. Slott, and this issue was no different. Peter's mission statement that no one die seemed like foolish hubris at the time, but even though death is inescapable, here we still get to see the difference made by every single life he saves.

What really made me tear up, though, is that this issue sings the praises of an uncle. There's not a lot of fiction that really highlights aunts and uncles. I have two 9-year-old nieces (Hannah and Harper) and a 3-year-old nephew (Gabe) to whom I am godfather. It's the most important role I have in life. If anything were to happen to their parents, they know they'd have me. I've found myself consumed for years by my work as a nonprofit attorney representing foster youth, and so for whatever reason, having my own kids hasn't happened for me. But it's never mattered, because I am so fulfilled by my relationship with those three kids. I remember running to the hospital when the girls were born. Talking them through their problems, highlighting the importance of having compassion for people around us. I go to their plays, have fun at the holidays. It's all here. I'd like to think I'd trip that burglar, too. Uncle Ben in SPIDER-MAN taught me how important it is that we set an example for the next generation. I'm hoping I'll never need to die to do that.

On a plane flying to my family farm in Illinois recently, Harper looked over my shoulder while I was rereading "Dying Wish" and asked me to explain who Uncle Ben was. I did so, and she said, "That's just like you and us! You're teaching us to be good people!" It was all I could hope for. They set aside their own books and read my issues of AMAZING SPIDER-MAN the whole trip. Thank you for your run, Mr. Slott. And thank you for this issue I can hand my godkids to remind them I'll always be there for them. :)

I'm just gonna start off and say that Nick Spencer is my favorite writer. *The Fix*. SUPERIOR FOES. ANT-MAN. CAPTAIN AMERICA. *Morning Glories*. This dude has a solid repertoire of stories and the news of him taking over AMAZING SPIDER-MAN just melted me.

And Ryan Ottley... I love *Invincible* so much that I feel like I have a bond with Ryan without ever having met him or spoken to him. His art is phenomenal. I love him so much.

All this coalesces into a fantastic first issue. Nick bringing his on-point humor and Ryan beautifully crafting this world and set of characters has me immensely excited for this run. I won't name names of course, but I've felt that a few writers in this business come onto a new title and don't do much in their first issue to make it known they have a story to tell. I don't feel obligated to read the next issue. The way that Nick uses Dan Slott's run and weaves it into this story means so much to me because I really like Dan's run and I feel his presence in this issue despite his having left the book. Nick has a story to tell. It may be "back to basics," but it's built on the backs of other incredible runs and feels like a continuation.

The news of this book being biweekly has me excited since I'm already on board, but I hope Ryan gets to draw as much of this book as possible.

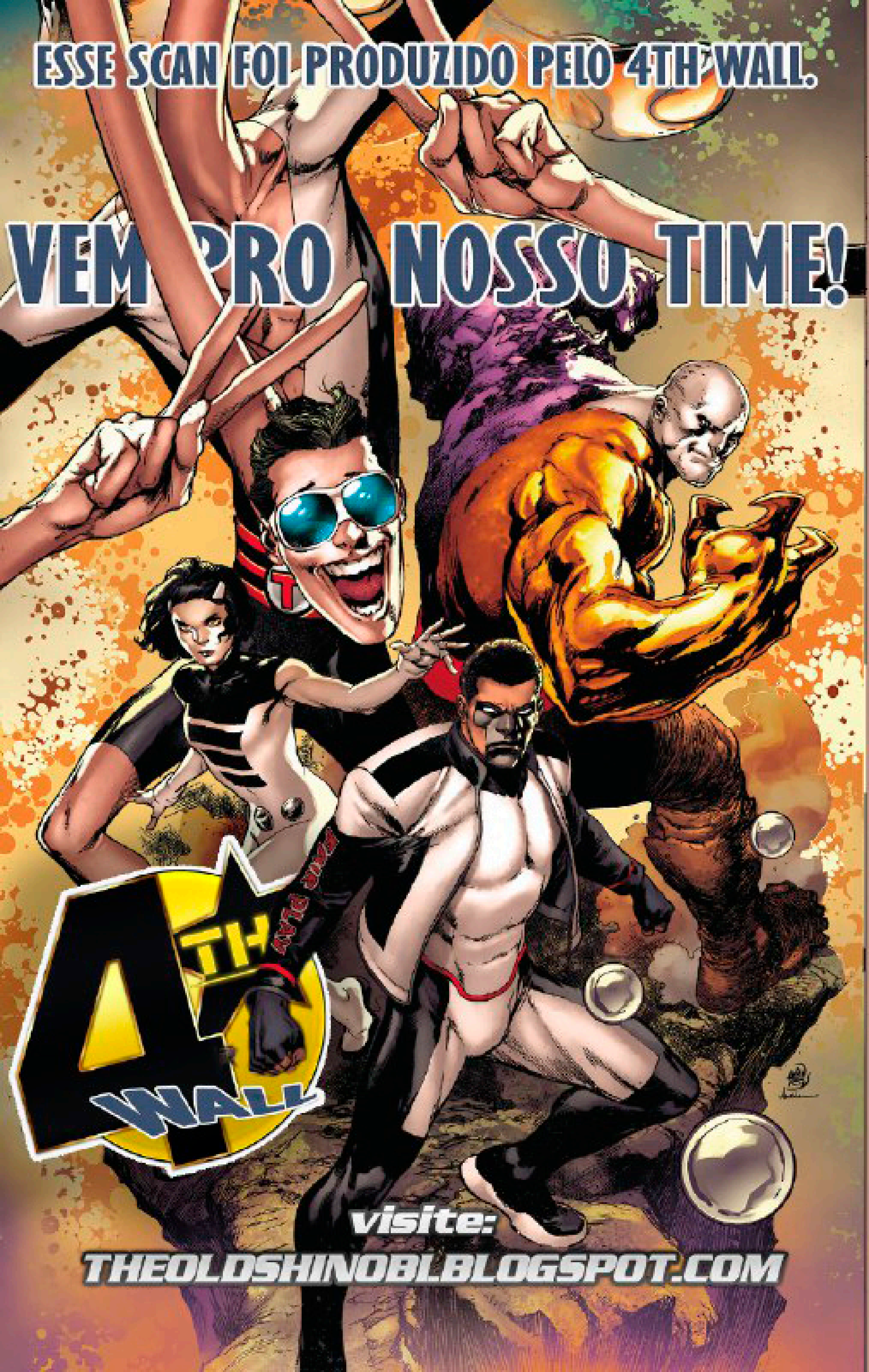


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
