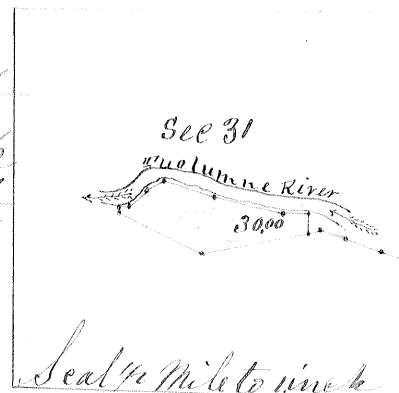

Field Notes.

Beginning on $\frac{1}{4}$ Section line in the South East $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 31. at the point of intersection with the U.S. Meander line. Thence run on $\frac{1}{4}$ Section line N 14° W 3.42 ch to the left bank of the Tuolumne River. Meander down Stream. Run West 5.83 ch, N 76° W 14.63 ch, N 74° W 10.83 ch, S 68° W 4.58 ch, S 46° W 4.39 ch, West 2.00 ch, to $\frac{1}{4}$ Section line in the South West $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 31. Thence run on $\frac{1}{4}$ Section line S 4° E 1.00 ch, to the U.S. Meander line. Thence run on U.S. Meander line S 64° E 19.81 ch, N 78° E 22.64 ch to the place of beginning. The above is a resurvey of No. 18 made Nov. 30th 1855 for Chester Witter.

Run by the true Meridian. Magnetic Variation $15^{\circ} 35'$ East.

Surveyed in accordance with the Act of the Legislature, concerning Swamp and Overflowed Lands approved April 18th 1850 and the instruction of the Surveyor General.
