Is Your Name in the Lamb's Book of Life? (Keith Jenkins)

Every message to churches in Revelation is also a standard that God will use for us. In Revelation three we read about the church in Sardis. This is a message to you and me. The judgements Jesu made on the churches in Revelation are serious. He will not say that there is a more modern interpretation now of what He originally said to these churches and that His judgement has changed. God is not a man that He should lie. He is not going to repent of what He said. **The standard then is the same standard now.** Let us not adjust the Word of God to fit our doctrine but rather adjust our doctrine to fit the Word of God! I remind you, every word to the churches in Revelation chapters two and three is relevant to us today! If you read this passage and it makes you nervous, then praise God! You are blessed as this means you still have a chance to repent. We have to work out our salvation daily (Philippians 2:12). If you do what those churches were told not to do then you will suffer the same consequences they did. If this convicts you, you need to repent!

God does not change; He does not become lukewarm or 'turn a blind eye'. He can make an exception or delay a judgement but only to give us a chance to repent (2 Peter 3:9). **What He said about sin yesterday is true today.** If you feel nervous about what He has said, that is good as it can cause you to cry out for mercy and forgiveness. Through repentance, God will cleanse you and give you a fresh start. Maybe you do not have the faith you need at present because you had a 'lukewarm born again experience' Maybe someone told you that you were awesome and wonderful and that you did God a favour when you gave your life to Him. You never fully understood the seriousness of your condition and how lost you were. You need to recognize that you deserve hell for your sins even now and how wretched you are without God.

This may seem harsh, but when I look at my own wretched state and the amount of times that God has given me another chance, I realize it was so that I could make a fresh start and trust Him. I see that I am a chief of sinners too. We can make mistakes but let us not make the same mistakes again and again. Please ask the Lord why He has given you so many chances to repent. I know He forgives me time and again, and I believe His grace had a purpose. **It is only by faith in Jesus Christ that I stand!** It is only because I believe that God is full of grace for those who humble themselves and seek to repent. I also believe that what God started from the beginning, He will finish, but what I started will fail.

Is your faith in yourself? Do you think if you read the whole Bible you will somehow understand it all? I have no such confidence. My confidence is in the Holy Spirit Who tells me what to do. If He tells me to do something right now, I will do it. When He tells me to do another thing I will do that as well. I do not need to understand the process that works out my salvation. He knows the plan and why I was forgiven. I simply trust the Holy Spirit.

God is too big for our puny minds. Some may be satisfied with church and feeling the presence of God but that does not make us more spiritual. If we know the Holy Spirit and do not obey Him, then you are lukewarm. That is a dangerous place to be! By the grace of God you may occasionally feel the Spirit of God. But if you are truly hungry and thirsty to know God, you want to know why you not enjoying His presence all the time. You need to ask God why you do not have this all the time. I do not want to settle for feeling God's presence occasionally. I want to live in the holy of holies all the time. I want to feel conviction if I sin so I can repent and be saved in the end.

In the Old Testament, the presence of God was felt in the outer court of the temple, but there was a place beyond that called the Holy of Holies. Many believers never spend time in the holiest place with their Father. They afraid to go there or aren't willing to go there, because in that place, their flesh has to die. Some are happy with some music to bring them a taste of God's presence, but this alone will never make anyone spiritual! What makes you spiritual is to abide in God's presence, hear the Holy Spirit, and obey what He says!

We need to clearly understand that judgement is about to fall upon the church (1 Pet 4 v 17). Many think judgement is falling on the world, but I can see the judgement coming soon on the church! Prophecies are coming together and the end times are approaching. But before all that, judgement will start in the house of God. We are getting closer and closer to that time when significant scriptures will be fulfilled. However I believe we need to be ready all the time.

Psalm 46 v 10, “Let be *and* be still, and know (recognize and understand) that I am God. I will be exalted among the nations! I will be exalted in the earth!” (AMPC) When the time comes for God to be exalted among the heathen then people will start running from the wrath of God. We do not want to face that day without meeting God’s standards! This day has already begun for the church and God’s judgement is beginning in His house.

Revelation 3 v 1 “And to the angel (messenger) of the assembly (church) in Sardis write: These are the words of Him Who has the seven Spirits of God [the sevenfold Holy Spirit] and the seven stars: I know your record *and* what you are doing; you are supposed to be alive, but [in reality] you are dead.” (AMPC) **This is speaking to the church today!** The church of today is not ready. God hates sin and He knows all our works. He is the chief accountant! He sees what we are doing and where we are now. You are supposed to be alive for Him, but in reality, are you dead? You may go to a church where everything is comfortable. The people may love each from their own fleshly ability, yet they do not seek what is available in the Spirit. They think more of what they are going to get than what they can give. Very few believers want to be poured out like a drink offering as Paul the Apostle did. In most churches today, there is little or no godly fear. Instead people want teaching that tickles ears or makes them laugh and feel good. If there is no conviction in your church then it is a dead church because a comfortable church is a dead church.

If you are trying to work out your salvation by understanding the Bible with your mind, you are wasting your time. Your carnal natural mind will never understand the things of God (1 Cor 2). We do not learn that which is spiritual by adding more knowledge! The more we know of God’s ways and His requirements, the greater our responsibility to do what He says. If we do not obey what He says to us personally then we are opening ourselves up to His judgement for not doing what we know! To whom more is given more is required (Luke 12:48).

The purpose of this teaching is not to help you gather information you do not need. You already know enough to change the world. The question is: What are you doing with the knowledge you already have? If you are faithful in the truth you have, then you will be given more. The word that proceeds out of His mouth brings life (Isa 55:10-11). This is not just reading the Bible but hearing God’s truth by the Spirit which produces repentance, growth, and new life. You must ask yourself, are you dead or are you alive?

What does it mean to be alive? Is your definition the same as God’s? Does it simply mean that you are breathing? God told Adam and Eve that if they took from the tree of knowledge of good and evil then, **in that day**, they would surely die! That message has not changed yet is not taught today in most churches! Every day, when you take from the tree of knowledge of good and evil, if you are not already dead, then you are going to die. Paul says if you do not kill the flesh you will die (Romans 8:13).

You do not need to know any more than what God wants you to do now. If you do not live your life depending on hearing the Holy Spirit then you are not alive to the Spirit and you will end up alive to this world and the devil. There is no third category. If you are alive to the cares and concerns of this world then you are spiritually blind. Your eyes may be physically open but your concern is with what you see in the natural world around you; everything that is tangible, everything that makes sense to your mind. Everything you can see and understand with your mind is temporal and not eternal. If you really want to live, the old carnal way of thinking reasoning must die first.

Verse 2 “Rouse yourselves *and* keep awake, and strengthen *and* invigorate what remains and is on the point of dying; for I have not found a thing that you have done [any work of yours] meeting the requirements of My God *or* perfect in His sight.” (AMPC) Some people cannot stay awake. If a teaching goes on longer than they want they start to go to sleep. Everyone seems to have a cut-off point. There is no cut-off point with God if you are seeking salvation! Charles Finney’s average sermon was in excess of two hours and nobody left. The people understood the wretched nature of their condition and did not want to leave until their salvation was assured. They needed to be **saved for eternity**, not merely saved because they put up their hand and accepted Jesus at one moment in time. Charles Finney offered a meeting where they could enquire further into the condition of their soul. At these meetings they learnt that they were BEING saved and that this required leaving the old lifestyle and the temptations with it. They were strengthened and invigorated so they would not return to the way they were.

Many are dying today simply because they do not listen to the Holy Ghost. They are told, even by their leaders, to use common sense! Look at what God says here! “I have not found [any of] your deeds completed in the sight of My God *or* meeting His requirements.” Have you any idea how many times you need to read this scripture so that the Spirit can minister God’s truth to you? You need to read the truth, under the direction and in the presence of the Spirit, until it changes you. The only way you can do anything that is pleasing in His sight is by faith alone in response to what He tells you to do. This is not based on ideas of philosophy and instruction by man but ONLY when you incline your ear to Him and invite the Holy Ghost to tell you what He wants you to do.

You need to realise that nothing good lives in you (Romans 7:18) such that you do nothing other than listen to Him and live by faith alone. Faith is the only way you can be justified (Romans 3:28). You cannot be justified by following a system, doctrine, or set of rules. You will not be able to ‘wave’ this at God and argue that it was in His Word! Do you know that you can be right and wrong at the same time? You can quote the rule book or somebody’s idea about the rules but we are not under any law. If what you are doing does not line up with what the Holy Ghost wanted you to do at a specific time, then you are bringing forth death not life! The Holy Spirit is our only chance to have life.

This is a mystery to many because they read the Bible like a rule book and think that because they follow the rules they are alive. There is only one correct version of the Bible in the world and that is the one that is illuminated, not by your own mind, but by the

Spirit of God moment by moment as you read it! He uses scripture to train and direct you in a way you cannot see if you try it yourself. We do not follow a set of principles. Instead we follow Jesus by listening to the Spirit. Christianity is not merely another religion; it is a relationship with a living God.

I Corinthians 3 v 6 “I planted, Apollos watered, but God [all the while] was making it grow *and* [He] gave the increase.” (AMPC) It is the blood and Spirit that bring life. The blood Jesus shed on the cross causes you to become born again, but the Spirit is the only way for you to have life. There is forgiveness at the cross but there is life by doing what the Spirit says. The life is in the blood because this is how I got born again. The Spirit is the ONLY way we can understand God’s ways.

If God judges His people, based on this standard is that really fair? Is the church going to put God on trial in court and ask God to explain himself! If we judge God and are waiting for God to explain himself we are wasting time. Some think God will answer to the church. God is always right. He gave life and He can take it and He is still right. Some are happy with their ignorance and do not want any hard teaching. Not knowing much will not excuse anyone from reaching God’s standard. God has given us the Holy Spirit because He wants us to understand and know Him (Jeremiah 9:23-24).

Excuses will never work with God because He has given us the Holy Spirit and grace so we can do anything that He wants us to do. The Holy Spirit was never intended to make us feel good! Is the Spirit not the very wisdom of God? Does He not know the thoughts of God? (Phil. 2:13) Does He not understand the council of God? Does He not understand everything about God? **And we have Him within us!** Is this not what we believe about the Trinity! We use the word *Trinity* to describe three personalities that are 100% God. But God is One. The Holy Spirit, as well as Jesus Christ, are truly God!

Verse 3 “So call to mind the lessons you received and heard; continually lay them to heart *and* obey them, and repent. In case you will not rouse yourselves *and* keep awake *and* watch, I will come upon you like a thief, and you will not know *or* suspect at what hour I will come.” (AMPC) Here He refers to the lessons the church received and heard in the past. It is good to keep a notebook of what God has shown you. I invite you to refer to the lessons you have heard from Joseph Hedgecock and the messages on how to hear the voice of God and listen carefully and obey what He is saying. Do not use your mind trying to understand how to do the perfect will of God but instead follow the inner witness of the Spirit, the peace of God, and the Word. You need to get rid of anything that hinders you from hearing His voice.

You need to repent regularly as you work out your salvation! If you are NOT repenting regularly, something is wrong and you definitely need to repent! Without repentance you will never be able to receive and apply the truth in the way God wants. You need to repent when God shows you something through reading or hearing a message. Time is running out for all of us and repentance should be a daily activity that takes us from one level to another in our walk with God. God is not interested in our wisdom; He has His own! He warns us that if we will not get ready and wake up then He will come as a thief in the night and we will not know about His coming! It is our own wisdom and confidence in our man-made doctrines that keep us asleep.

Jesus taught many times about the need to be ready and used the illustration of a thief in the night to try to explain to us that we will never know when He will come. Some have predicted when Jesus will come but it does not matter what they say as we need to be ready every day. If you are not ready today you may never be ready. When are you going to get ready; maybe tomorrow? But tomorrow may be too late. You have got to be ready today! We can only do this by working on what the Spirit is saying now.

What does it take to be ready? It takes humility and faith. You have to believe that you can be on His side even though you are a wretched sinner and have not obeyed. You must repent and stop doing your own will and agree to only do what God has been telling you. You have listened to the wrong voice up to now. You need to confess that sin and admit you are carnal. When you humble yourself, you are ready but you must also stay ready by listening and obeying. Faith without following the Spirit is more dead works.

It is not by any act of your own righteousness. You can only stand by faith. You have to believe that His Spirit dwelling within you is not just for a day or a week but for a lifetime. You have to believe He is your helper and is there so that you can obey Him at the time. All you have to do is incline your ear, come to Him and hear (Isaiah 55:3). God will then make an everlasting covenant with you.

Verse 4: “Yet you still have a few [persons’] names in Sardis who have not soiled their clothes, and they shall walk with Me in white, because they are worthy *and* deserving.” (AMPC) Do you realise that you have to be worthy and deserving of those clothes? How did Jesus keep Himself clean, without spot or wrinkle? He did it by triumphing over the cross and all the shame of that death.

We all need to come to the cross and get clean. If we humble ourselves we can bathe ourselves in the grace of God and feel the Holy Spirit upon us. We love the benefits of the cross but how many follow Jesus' example and take up their own cross?

How many compare the suffering of Christ on the cross in times of suffering in time of trial and difficulty? Many want to get rid of the hard times and believe that suffering is not necessary. They say Christ suffered on the cross for us and there is now no need for us to suffer! They say they do not need to go through trials and difficulties as Jesus took all that for us. This is simply not true! If you read the Bible and come to that conclusion, you are wrong! Many who have believed this lie have shipwrecked their faith. The purifying of our faith through trials is necessary and important. God uses situations to prepare us for what He has called us to do. If you are going through trials and difficulties right now because of following Christ, you are blessed. You are on the path of being prepared for that day when Jesus is coming. You go through trials and difficulties in order to purify your faith in Him. Do not be ashamed of those troubles as they are your best help to prepare you and keep you on track!

The scripture says we should not soil our clothes. My mum used to tell me to go out and play and not get my clothes dirty. I did not always pay much attention but I knew what she meant! Spiritually, we are given a garment that becomes clean when we confess our sins and we get cleaned up. Every time you confess your sins to God, He is faithful and just and will forgive your sins all over again and cleanse you from all unrighteousness (1 John 1:9). That effectively gives you another clean set of clothes. How long they stay clean depends upon you!

If you play in the mud you will get dirty, but if you walk in His paths, even though you walk through the valley of death, your clothes will not get dirty! Why? Because He is with you. You only went through the valley because God told you to go there by the Holy Spirit. When you are righteous, you go anywhere God wants you to go. You are in Him so your clothes do not get dirty!

Years ago, after my breaking, I was afraid of doing a lot of ministry because I saw how this had drawn me away from God before and I did not want that to happen again. I told God that I wanted to stay close to Him. I told Him that I only wanted to go where He told me to go, doing what He told me to do. This is how God called me back into ministry. We have to abide and 'trust and obey'. This has become a way of life for me. The devil isolates believers and then entices them away with clever words. But you can get back. You do not have to listen to others. It is possible to listen only to His voice. It is your choice. You can walk the narrow way and make sure that you never soil your clothes because you never know in what day He will come! If you continually overcome by listening and obeying then you are ready.

Verse 5 "Thus shall he who conquers (is victorious) be clad in white garments, and I will not erase *or* blot out his name from the Book of Life; I will acknowledge him [as Mine] *and* I will confess his name openly before My Father and before His angels." (AMPC) Matthew 10 v 33 "But whoever denies *and* disowns Me before men, I also will deny *and* disown him before My Father Who is in heaven." (AMPC) Christianity is not a religion; it is a relationship with a living God. If you disown the Spirit of Christ within then you are disowning Christ. It is serious to have the Holy Spirit and not obey Him (Acts 5:32).

John 10: 7-11 "So Jesus said again, I assure you, most solemnly I tell you, that I Myself am the Door for the sheep. ⁸ All others who came [as such] before Me are thieves and robbers, but the [true] sheep did not listen to *and* obey them. ⁹ I am the Door; anyone who enters in through Me will be saved (will live). He will come in and he will go out [freely], and will find pasture. ¹⁰ The thief comes only in order to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have *and* enjoy life, and have it in abundance (to the full, till it overflows). ¹¹ I am the Good Shepherd. The Good Shepherd risks *and* lays down His [own] life for the sheep." (AMPC)

Here, Jesus' definition of life is not 'life' that is not dreams and hopes that may never come to fruition. The very purpose of Jesus coming was to give life to you and me. This life came because He also lay down His life for the sheep. This life is promised to you and me as children of God. The question is whether or not we are experiencing it! Life comes when we do the Lord's will and follow Him. We can enjoy eternal life now as we stay within the boundaries that He has set for us.

Another question: Are we listening to the truth or to some other voice? We must receive directions from the Holy Spirit to overcome. If you are not an overcomer, you are listening to a wrong voice. When a problem comes, do you complain, make excuses, and question what God is doing? You may believe that if He knew what He was doing He would prevent your problems. If you cannot rejoice, who are you listening to? A true overcomer sees every circumstance as another opportunity to overcome listening and following the Master.

You ask someone who is an overcomer how they overcame and they will tell you it was by the blood of the Lamb and the word of their testimony, and that they loved not their lives unto death! Preachers who entice you with nice words and say things that appeal to your flesh often leave out this last phrase. However, there is no way of getting around denying self. There is no victory without taking up your cross. This means we do 'not love our lives unto death!' There is no way around the truth that if you love this world then satan has access to you! If you are entangled with the cares of this life, satan has access to you.

BUT if you want to be an overcomer, it is very simple. Any time you sin, you must confess it and get back to God again. We need the blood of the Lamb to remove the sin that separates us from God. Only through confession of sin and telling the truth and true repentance are you completely made clean and can have a clear conscience. You will only be satisfied when you get back into the Holy of Holies and have communion with God. Then you will hear His solutions and find out how to overcome. There is no set way to overcome in any situation. But I do know that God knows what to do, and all I have to do is rely entirely upon Him. Whatever situation I am in, I know that all I have to do is hear. I cannot be thinking of myself or I will not have ears to hear what He wants me to do!

Matthew 10:28-40 is good counsel. Verse 28: "And fear not them which kill the body, but are not able to kill the soul: but rather fear Him which is able to destroy both soul and body in hell." If the people of God would fear Him more then, they would stop sinning. **It is the lack of the fear of God that keeps people in sin today.** Do you really know what it means to fear God? Take some time to ponder on this!

In Matthew 10 Verse 29 “Are not two sparrows sold for a farthing? and one of them shall not fall on the ground without your Father. ³⁰But the very hairs of your head are all numbered. ³¹Fear ye not therefore, ye are of more value than many sparrows. (We matter a lot to God!) ³²Whosoever therefore shall confess me before men, him will I confess also before my Father which is in heaven. ³³But whosoever shall deny me before men, him will I also deny before my Father which is in heaven. ³⁴Think not that I am come to send peace on earth: I came not to send peace, but a sword. ³⁵For I am come to set a man at variance against his father, and the daughter against her mother, and the daughter in law against her mother in law. ³⁶And a man's foes shall be they of his own household. ³⁷He that loveth father or mother more than me is not worthy of me: and he that loveth son or daughter more than me is not worthy of me. ³⁸And he that taketh not his cross, and followeth after me, is not worthy of me. ³⁹He that findeth his life shall lose it: and he that loseth his life for my sake shall find it. ⁴⁰He that receiveth you receiveth me, and he that receiveth me receiveth him that sent me.” (KJV)

In Revelation 20 we see what will happen in the last days and the great judgement that is coming on this earth. In verse 10 we read “And the devil that deceived them was cast into the lake of fire and brimstone, where the beast and the false prophet are, and shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever. ¹¹And I saw a great white throne, and him that sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away; and there was found no place for them. ¹²And I saw the dead, small and great, stand before God; and the books were opened: and another book was opened, which is the book of life: and the dead were judged out of those things which were written in the books, (plural!) “according to their works.”

Everything we have thought, said, and done is recorded in heaven. What you do in your life speaks much louder than what you say. What you do indicates what you believe in your heart. You can say you have faith but faith without works is dead. Everything you do is an act of faith. If it is an act of faith based on the Holy Ghost's instructions, this brings life. When you have obeyed God perfectly, this will go in the Book of Life because it is life, because it came from God and He is life. All I have to do is listen, trust and obey

It is true, your name did get there the day you were born again. There is life in the blood of Christ so that was applied to you when you were born again and by grace your name was written in the Lamb's book of life. Your name going there had nothing to do with your works or you. All you did was use the measure of faith you given by God to believe on the Lord Jesus Christ. Because of your faith your name was written there! The writing of your name in the Book was everything to do with God and nothing to do with you or me. It is not anything you or I deserved or achieved other than believing on Jesus. BUT it is only your name that is in that Book at salvation.

Revelation 3:2 “for I have not found a thing that you have done [any work of yours] meeting the requirements of My God or perfect in His sight.” God has looked at the works of the church and has found nothing in all that they have done that is acceptable to His high and holy standards. Do you think that anything that has not reached God's standards is going to make it to Heaven?

Some of you may have the book, Wake Up, Time is Running Out. You may notice that I am included in that book. I am honoured that my name is mentioned there but below these is also a testimony of what happened to me. If your name is written in the lamb's Book and you want to be sure that you are an overcomer put more text in there! Why just have your name on salvation when you can have so much there. This is the lamb's book of life and will include testimonies from all those who confess their sins and hear His voice. There will be much more than just your name. There will be a record of how you followed Christ and did not lean on your own understanding. But this only include the things done in obedience to God and His ability to use you to achieve His purposes and perfect plan.

There will be many books opened on the last day. Either you will have a record in the Lamb's book of life or one of the other books that will be opened at the last great judgement. There will be books that describe your life and all that you have done. “Every hair on your head is numbered!” These books will be detailed and angels will open them for all those who lived carnal lives. In these books there will be great detail about every act so that there is a clear record of what everyone did. Everyone will get what he or she deserves and the books will prove whether someone was really carnal or spiritual. God is no respecter of persons! Those records are being kept so that there can be no discussion about what we did or did not do and what we have failed to do. Every wrong motive will be exposed and the fire of God will reveal all.

Rejoice if your name is written in that book. You will find my name in the Lamb's Book of life because I had a ‘salvation’ experience when I was 18 years old but because Jesus is my Lord now and He directs my life there will be more than just my name. Paragraph after paragraph of my life is now there. You will find stories about me in that Book BUT it will be nothing that I have done in my own strength or on my own initiative. If there is anything of me written anywhere then it will be in another book, not the lamb's Book of Life. The things that the Holy Spirit has told me to do and that I did in obedience to Him by faith without questioning Him they will be in the Book of life.

Some born again carnal believers are going to be surprised on the day of Judgement. They may have been faithfully going to church; confessed Jesus as saviour; done many good works but these will not be things the Holy Spirit told them to do. Even pastors will stand there and say “Lord, Lord, did I not do this in your name?” (Matthew 7:22-23). They may have a lot to say but none of it will count unless it meets God's standards and it was a work that He predestined for you to do (Ephesians 2:10).

Revelation 21 verse 27 “And there shall in no wise enter into it any thing that defileth, neither whatsoever worketh abomination, or maketh a lie: but they which are written in the Lamb's book of life.” (KJV) Here we read that this is a pure Book that only contains things that meet God's requirements. If you are feeling nervous then let me tell you that the only way forward for you is by faith. This may be your last chance but it is a good chance and you need to repent. This is still the day of repentance; it is not yet finished. By grace you are given another chance, even though you have made many false attempts you can still have another chance. Even the many failures can become stepping stones to God's glory as they become a testimony to others of what God can

do despite your many failures. Others will see and be amazed. Those who have made excuses and say that they have tried hearing God will listen and be convicted. Those who do not believe the sinless life is possible will be put to shame.

If you let the power of the Holy Spirit direct consistently then you have truly been changed. If He is really functioning as Lord of your life then you have become a living soul. You will not be recognisable by your own family and friends. People who knew you will see you have changed.

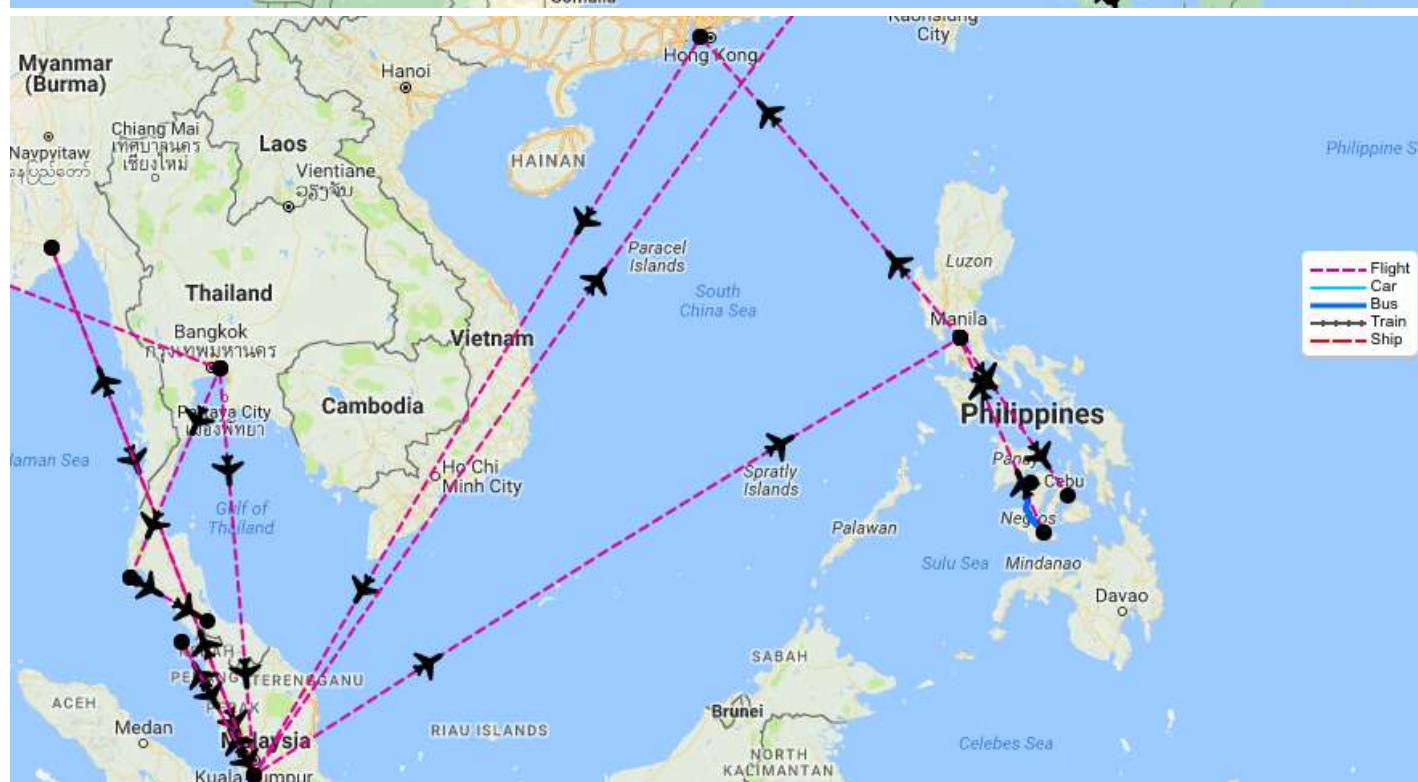

Trip to Germany, Sweden and Eastern Europe in April 2017

This trip started the day after the eye appointment where the doctor gave me an all clear to travel. I was only allowed to take hand carry-on bags because of the restriction of carrying items after a detached retina. This was a miracle because I was only informed that I could fly the day before, but God told me this would happen so I booked the flight in faith. I arrived in Stuttgart Airport in Germany. Martin and Pia Geldmacher picked me up and we drove for about 3 hours to a conference organised in Lenzkirch in the Black Forest, Germany. I spoke on "How to Read the Bible Properly", "How to get the Witness of the Holy Spirit" and "How the Scriptures Can Come Back to Your Mind". I also talked about the need to have a renewed mind. I explained what the renewed mind was and how to maintain the peace of God so that the Holy Spirit can put thoughts into our minds. Recordings are available from Martin and Pia. I had several sessions. Yolanda was also present and she spoke on Saturday night and Sunday.

I had to leave at 1am on Sunday morning and Jörg Dennebaum took me to Strasbourg airport which was generally on his way home. Joshua Oelschlaegel was also in the car asking questions, even at 1-2 in the morning! There was no rest for the preacher but that was fine. We got to the airport at about 3am and were the first to arrive. The airport was not open! By 3:30am or 4am they started opening the airport. My flight left at 6:15am, left early, and arrived early as well. When I got to Corsica, I arrived at Bastia Airport which was about two hours' drive from the place where I was preaching in Calvi. The pastor picked me up. He was living in Bastia, but he arranged to collect me up in Bastia Airport and a translator, who lived in the same area, on the way. We all went together to Calvi on windy roads. At this point I had only a couple of hours so I lay down in the back of the car. We arrived on time at the meeting. Waltraud was there to greet us. She was very excited that I had come all that way. The church had organised a meal afterwards so that people had time to ask questions. We went to a restaurant at the beach. When we sat at a table the person opposite me was also asking questions about the message. A pastor made a comment while we were sitting at the table that he never heard teaching on how to read the Bible properly like he heard that day. He was very open and wanted me to return. He had driven an hour and a half to be at the meeting. There were about 15-20 people in the meeting on Sunday morning. This was a good-size church gathering for Corsica!

After the service I had a little bit of time to repack my bag, get things together, and then leave that afternoon for a trip to Paris. The airport was 15 minutes' drive from the home of Waltraud but I had left something behind so she had to go back and get my coat. It was a long journey ahead and I would need it. I got a bus on arrival from Paris and travelled by Eurolines from Paris to Brussels to meet Bert Spaans. Bert then took me to Charleroi Airport so I could fly to Copenhagen with Ryanair early in the morning. At this point I had only had about a couple of hours in the bus station in Paris to rest beforehand and on the bus itself, before meeting Bert. When I arrived in Copenhagen, I had to get two trains to Sweden. The second train was more expensive than the flight from Brussels to Copenhagen! I tried to get a discounted fare on the internet but I was not able. I arrived on time by train. The pastor picked me up in Brusonholm and drove about 1 hour. I had a couple of hours' rest before the meeting and some food. Then everyone arrived. I then had to get to the airport then next morning in Linköping. Then the brother who invited me saw my schedule and realised it was just as easy for him to take me directly to the airport. So he did that at about 3 o'clock in the morning! So I had a third night with very little sleep. Somehow God was giving me strength to do all these meetings.

When I flew to Amsterdam, the KLM flight was very empty just carrying four people from Linköping to Amsterdam but the flight operator lost my bag which was full of books and some personal items. Before I got on that flight, I asked the Lord what to pack and leave in that bag. I ask Him about such details because He knows what is going to happen next. The Lord had me take out every important document and some computer cables. I filled my hand-carry size bag with books and just a few clothes around to protect the books which came to about 20kg. So when I flew, I had all the other things, including some extra clothing needed tucked away in my coat pockets and in my small white bag I had all my important documents. When I arrived in Amsterdam, they told me my bag had gone missing. They spent some time trying to find it. Fortunately my bus did not leave immediately! I had plenty of time to fill out the paperwork so that they could forward the bag directly to my home. The airline did this at their own expense. This was a real blessing because the weight of the bag was so heavy, I could not really take it on my next flight so when I heard they had lost it I was rejoicing inside! The books inside it, I needed in the UK! Losing my bag with KLM was an answer to prayer. Pia was the one who just happened to be in the office at the right time when the books were delivered. She was supposed to be at a homegroup meeting that evening, but received my email that the bag would be delivered that evening and no one else was available to be there. For the next meetings each place already had all the books they needed. So this was God's well organised plan in action!

From Amsterdam I travelled by bus to Germany where I was to meet Elke Meyer. She was to bring some books. I was also to speak that night and stay the night with a couple where I had spoken before. I spoke at this meeting on "How to Read the Bible Properly". The next morning I travelled early again at 09:40 on a bus to Berlin. While I was on this bus I met Nikita as she joined it at the next station after. We were able to catch up and talk a bit before she had to get off along the way for a meeting. This was an amazing arrangement to meet her because she was only just in Germany for a few days. She lives by faith and travels around the world and we happened to be on the same bus! I arrived in Berlin about 30 minutes late and the host came to pick me up and we just about made it in time for the start of meeting. I did not have any chance to rest. Instead of sleeping on the bus I used the time to answer 30-40 e-mails because there was free Wifi on board. No rest for the preacher again!

In Berlin I was able to speak again on "Hearing the Lord" and "How We can Get in His Presence and Hear God All the Time". The group was very excited with the message and wanted me to return as soon as I could.

This meeting was in the East Berlin. There was no available flight from Berlin to Skopje (Macedonia) which was my next destination. So I had to get on an overnight train and then fly out of Dortmund. The people I stayed with in Dortmund before agreed to help by picking me up at the train station when I arrived in the early hours and then take me to the airport. I surely needed this help because it would have been very difficult to get to the airport otherwise. Again, hardly any sleep. The flight arrived on time and I was picked up at the airport by the personal assistant to the pastor.

The lady who met me was very concerned that I was to see all the tourist sights of Skopje. I eventually had to explain to her that I had not had much sleep. So I did have a nice meal and, after lunch, was able to get a few hours rest. I only had 30 minutes to share in Skopje so I asked to see the pastor as well just to discuss a few details beforehand and he had mentioned how he had met brother Hedgecock in Germany at a conference and he was very interested in this message. As I began to share, he became more and more excited. He expressed his frustration because he really found the need to hear God in everything he was doing. His frustration came when he explained this to some local pastors and got shocked looks as they were following principles in the Bible and found it strange that someone could hear God all the time. So he said "When I served satan, I heard his voice, but now I am serving Christ, I expected to hear God and do what He says." But when he shared it with other pastors, he found it hard to believe that anyone could not hear God so clearly especially coming from his experience of serving the devil. Most of the opposition he gets has come from born-again Christians. But God blessed his ministry. He now not only has a local congregation of about a hundred, but other churches in other cities have been established and now, on a regular week-night, he preaches to nearly 400 people in the region through the live streaming because he had been hearing God and God had been showing him what to do. In the evening I shared about hearing God consistently and using the three infallible witnesses. Afterwards the pastor wanted to buy one of every book for the church and also then bought several copies of Wake Up! Volumes 1 and 2 for his leaders. The church booked the bus for me from Skopje to Thessaloniki. I left early morning at 6am.

I arrived in Thessaloniki about 30 minutes late. I was met by Yanni, who is translating the Greek books, in the bus station. He was happy to take me by taxi to the airport because the bus was late. Using the taxi gave us some time in the airport for me to repack my bags and for him to ask questions and for us to spend some time together. Then I flew from there to Athens. I arrived at 15:35, was picked up and taken to the meeting. I was hosted by the pastor of an African congregation. Quite a few people came much later than advertised. The pastor had arranged everything in one place in a hotel so I could stay in the room and have rest a little bit before everybody arrived. The next morning I had plenty of time to rest and I slept until 12 o'clock mid-day in the hotel in Athens as they let me use the room until 2 o'clock. This was possible because on this second day there was a second session at 5pm in the same hotel. Both messages were on "True Repentance and Learning to Listen to the Holy Spirit and see what He is Saying". Some people liked the message, some people did not, but then immediately after the second day, again I had to rush to get to the airport. I had arranged to get the local bus to the airport, so there was not a lot of time after the meeting as my flight to Cologne was at 22:20 that night. In the evening I flew from there to Cologne. Bert Spaans picked me up again. The flight was 20 to 30 minutes late and when we finally reached his house at 2 o'clock in the morning I had just a few hours rest. I was up again at 8am in the morning in order to get breakfast and get to the church meeting in Vervier, Belgium. There I spoke at the Alliance church. My host was Pastor Alain. They were delighted to see me and host me. I spoke on the "Spiritual Versus the Carnal Mind". After the meeting I left very quickly in order to reach the airport and fly back from there to Manchester. My flight was on time. I caught a bus to Stoke and Dave Kennard picked me up. I did not get home until the evening. Great trip. I arrived home refreshed.

Short trip to Belgium, Germany and Israel in June 2017

I could not take a computer with me on this trip because of restrictions on airlines for people carrying a computer back into the UK at that time. So I had to travel quickly and then return. I flew to Eindhoven and stayed the night with Bert Spaans.

My first meeting was in Maaseik in Belgium the next morning. I spoke on John 10:27 and "The Need to Hear God All the Time" and shared some of my testimony. The pastor lived just two houses away from the church so we had lunch with him and he used the time to ask questions. We left around 15:00 and drove to the next meeting. Bert did not check the itinerary and we ended up in the right street, but in Charleroi. That was when we realized there was no church there and checked the address which was in a town next to it called Genappe! This was a Romanian church. Those attending were from Romania. I only had three Ministry books in Romanian – 'How Love Grows', 'Three Infallible Witnesses' and 'My Sheep Hear My Voice'. People were very keen to get the message and several people bought 'My Sheep Hear My Voice'. The pastor invited me back and afterwards I stayed the night with Bert again.

Early the next morning I left for Solingen where Joseph was speaking for a day seminar. This was well attended, but because one of the motorways in Germany was closed, it took us a little bit longer and we arrived one minute after the start. During the seminar Joseph spoke about "Doing Your Repentance Properly, Using a Notebook". Because the Holy Spirit told me to, I had taken my notebook as an example to show others. People crowded around a table to see how to set it up. This was a great seminar. People were very encouraged to have a go themselves. After the meeting Joseph stayed with one of the people from the meeting. We stayed with them and had some time together from about 19:00 until about 22:00, just talking and sharing together; a precious time together.

After that I travelled to Cologne Airport and flew to Tel Aviv with a very cheap flight and back again. I waited in Tel Aviv Airport for approximately an hour, and then took a bus direct to the centre of Jerusalem near the bus station for only about 10 Shekels. The bus also had free Wifi. Normally if you take a Scheroot bus (which is like a shared taxi), it is 60 Shekels. So this was great for me with just one bag. When I arrived in Jerusalem, one pastor came to meet me and we had lunch together and talked about the teaching. He asked questions about how he could get more messages and sermons from SOLM. He was very keen to do more. Then he called the people where I was staying and we both travelled, by public transport, to the place where I spoke at a homegroup. We had a lot of time together before the meeting.

I spoke in a homegroup meeting to mainly Finnish-speaking people. The meeting was led by a Jewish rabbi. I spoke on “How to Read the Bible Properly”. It was a very convicting message for the rabbi and everybody else because they saw the importance of waiting for the Holy Spirit to bring conviction. Afterwards there were many questions, but everybody seemed to be very convicted with the teaching.

From there I flew home. After the meeting I went to the airport very early in the morning. There was no one to take me so we had to take the Scherroot from the house directly to the airport. From there I flew back home via Istanbul where there was a very thorough search. Those who had electronic devices had them removed from their carry-on bags. This included laptops and large cameras. Each person had to pay an extra 30 Euros for the items to be put in a hold so that they did not lose them. I did not have that problem because I did not take my laptop with me! I arrived safely on time and Pia Sonnek came to the airport to collect me. I had an eye appointment scheduled for when I arrived back and could not change it but, although Pia was a little bit late, we stopped at the house to do something and I got to the eye appointment just in time. I was able to work on my emails when I arrived home.

Short visit to Canada and the USA in May 2017

I started my trip on the bus at 04:15 from Nottingham travelling to a flight from Gatwick. I was able to reach Toronto the same day for an evening meeting. I travelled for about 16 hours. I was met by a friend who I originally met in Romania from Satu Mare. He would translate for me at meetings and helped translate the book ‘My Sheep Hear My Voice’ when it was first printed. He took me to his home where I was able to collect some books I had left last year. Then we went to the meeting. This was advertised to be in a home and only a small number of people came, but the people were very excited by the message “How to Read the Bible Properly”. Afterwards some asked many questions about the peace of God, the witness of the Spirit and one person wanted to buy English versions of all of the books. The pastor was present at the meeting and listened carefully to the message.

The next morning I got an early and flew to Winnipeg where I met up with the son of a pastor from Rivne in the Ukraine. He was also the translator and in Winnipeg is the pastor of the Ukrainian Church. Again, I shared a message on “How to Read the Bible Properly”. He was touched by the message and asked questions about how he could be under somebody as he wanted to be trained in the Ministry. He really appreciated my visits and asked me to definitely return next year. I stayed with his family. He has four children.

The next morning I travelled to the USA via Denver on route for Seattle on the West Coast. I arrived quite tired but was able to get some rest during the night. In the morning I spoke at Bethel Chapel in Mountlake Terrace. In the morning service I was the main speaker, but there were two Nigerians who both gave strong messages about the importance of miracles, laying hands on the sick and doing ministry. Afterwards I gave a message for 1½ hours. But I started off by sharing the scripture in Matthew 7:22 and 23 that we can do nothing without first hearing from God. In the African culture there is too much emphasis on power and not enough on hearing God. So after the message many people were very challenged, they enjoyed the teaching and some of them had come especially to hear the message. The church was quite full for a Sunday morning service. In the afternoon I spoke at someone's home on "The Anointing of God and the Six Steps to God's Anointing". At that time I was tired from the travel and someone said "you look a bit tired" and I said I was a bit because of travelling.

I did not spend a second night in Seattle as I had to travel in the early morning to Dallas where I had scheduled to meet some leaders, but I met someone who was actually from the church where I had just preached. She had moved to Dallas and wanted to meet me while I was there. She was from Malaysia.
